

District/State Mandated Testing

Every student in the SRVUSD will take district assessments four times a year in math, reading, and writing. Aligning assessments across the district will support our district-wide implementation of the Common Core State Standards. The purpose of administering these assessments is not just to provide summative assessment information, but to utilize these assessments to inform our instructional practice.

Second graders across the district take the CogAt, or Cognitive Abilities Test, in the Spring. This test consists of three batteries, which measure verbal, quantitative and nonverbal abilities. More information will be sent home as the date approaches.

Second graders will not take part in the new Common Core State Standardized testing starting this year.
