### I. Welcome; Attendance; Approval of Minutes

### II. Principal / Teacher / Staff Updates

- GV celebrated Joanne Miloseski, the PTA President, at SRVEF's "Meet the Stars" banquet last night. Joanne was awarded the Shining Star Award in recognition of her dedication, passion, hard work, and exceptional service at GV for the past 2 years.

## III. 2022-2023 Budget Update / Discussion

- Discussion of recommendations for requested funds from LF.
- Proposed items include:
  - (i) <u>Makers Space / Purposeful Play IA</u> will cost approx. \$22K and will support parents' and teachers' desire for more STEM activities. It will also provide space, materials, and assistance for PBL lessons. Makers Space will be located in the old computer lab.
  - (ii) Art Docent budget of \$15K. Ideas include clay projects, weaving, and other art projects.
  - (iii) Marquee one time purchase of \$28K. At last meeting, we discussed how the marquee can benefit students and the GV community as a whole. This benefit can extend to supporting social-emotional learning by celebrating student achievements with COLT Cards, book of the month, vocabulary word of the week, relevant topics for discussion at the dinner table. Marquee may be placed where the existing marquee is located but this has not been finalized.
- Motion to approve budget proposal for LF support. All in favor, none oppose, motion carries.
- Learning Fund has the funding to support the requested asks. Donna will submit the above recommendations to the LF at its next meeting.
- Safety Subcommittee is preparing a Safety Plan document outlining the school's safety and emergency procedures.
- Prior to the next SC meeting, the Election Subcommittee will plant the application & election process for new members wishing to join SC.
