

Dear Teachers,

This is a quick and interesting science fair project good for elementary students. In this resource you will find all of the materials that you need throughout the project as well as the materials to make your tri fold board. There is also a parent letter and anchor charts for the scientific method included.

Student's will learn the importance of washing their hands to stay germ free.

To begin— you will need to purchase a loaf of bread. The type of bread can vary the experiment slightly. A fresh loaf of bread with as little extra preservatives as possible is most likely to give you the most drastic results. Label 3 baggies with control, clean, and dirty. Use a glove to place the control slice inside the first bag. Wash your hands and place the second piece of bread in the bag with your hands. Lastly let the students pass around the last piece of bread and have each student handle it before placing it into the bag labeled dirty. Display in classroom and observe changes over the next couple of days.

If there is something that you believe is missing from this product please let me know and I will work on adding it for you.

This experiment will take about a week to complete. Throughout the process we will be using the scientific method.


The Scientific Method steps include:

Ask a question, create a hypothesis, test your hypothesis, analyze your data, and share your results.

We will be growing mold on slices of bread. The bread will be handled in 3 different ways to observe the effects of using clean hands versus dirty hands.



EXPERIMENT MATERIALS

Why do we need to wash our hands?

First, we will place three pieces of bread in each bag labeled control, clean, and dirty. We will not touch the control. Next we will use clean hands to place the bread in the second bag. All students will touch the dirty bread before placing it in the bag. We will leave the bags out in the classroom and write down our data and observations each day.







Changes in experiment




