LANGUAGE ARTS

1. Cut apart comic strips, mix up, and re-sequence.
2. Make up your own comic strip using your favorite characters.
3. Create your own dictionary of new and exciting words to use in your writing. Illustrate the definition and write a sentence using the word.
4. Using a picture postcard or magazine picture, write a story about what you see.
5. Make a word search puzzle using your frog words.
6. Make a diorama of your favorite scene from your library book.
7. Write a letter to a friend or relative.

MATH

1. Using the 100's chart (10 by 10 grid), create a mystery picture by writing clues for a family member to solve.
2. Using your hands, measure 5 objects in your house. Write them in order from smallest to largest.
3. Make a story problem picture using stickers. Include the number sentence.
4. Using 3D shapes from around the house, build something of your choice (a robot, a building, a train). Bring to sharing.
5. Roll a pair of dice 20 times. Record the sums, and graph the results. Which number comes up the most?
6. Make your own set of flash cards for number facts to 10.
7. Find a recipe to read, measure, time, and prepare for your family. Get help from a grown-up to be safe!
