### V. 2021-2022: CAASP Results

- CAASPP State mandated testing 3-5th grade students
- Noted that this is the first time this cohort of students have taken this exam due to the Covid pandemic
- Reported results reflect percentage of proficient and advanced students per grade level

#### **Discussion Points:**

- A) Pre-covid norm was mid-range 80s for both ELA and Math
- B) How did Covid/online learning affect our scores?
- C) CAASPP, and all standardized state testing, is just one indicator of performance and is not perfect
- D) This data will be used as a baseline for the next three years
- E) Tracking each of these classes over the next three years will be helpful to determine growth
- F) How does our school compare with others in the area?
- G) Was behavior/SEL a factor in our results?
- H) Curricula:
  - a) New ELA program adoption in K-1 may help bolster results
  - b) We are several years into our math program

### VI. District Vision for the Future

- A. Deep Learning
  - Deep Learning lets students dive deeper into the curriculum and explore their interests while honing 21st Century Learning skills like critical thinking, collaboration, etc.
  - b. GV has been wanting to integrate Project-Based Learning (PBL) for several years, which is a complement to Deep Learning.
- B. Equity and Inclusion
  - a. Provide space for students to be who they are
  - b. Provide connections for kids to school, community, teachers
  - c. Includes social/emotional learning as well (SEL)
    - i. Safety will be a focus for GV

### VII. Goal Setting

- A. School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) Documents our goals for the year.
  - a. Review last year's plan
  - b. Make new goals (to be discussed in October)
    - i. Focus will be a few areas deeply rather than many broadly:
      - Goal examples could include one for academics, one for SEL, and one for Deep Learning
    - District goals will be tied to school goals
  - c. Approve New Goals (by December)
    - i. Ensure that they are measurable (stating metrics that will be used)
      - 1. CAASP/Fastbridge/other
    - ii. Demonstrate how they are aligned with district goals
  - d. Submit Goals to District and State
