III. CAASP Results

1. Over the past 12 years, some schools in our district have had higher scores, but different demographics. Comparison is not as important as our own scores and how it affects our students.
2. This will provide baseline for future growth during the next three years

IV. Safety

1. Overarching approach for catastrophic event (red folder)
 - a. Red and green signs, plus Standard response protocol for K12
 - b. Protocol from I Love You Guys (should this be in backpack for subs)
 - i. Hold - keep kids in room or area, clear halls
 - ii. Secure - double check gates
 - iii. Evacuate - evacuate building
 - iv. Shelter - stay where you are
 - v. Lockdown (will not be practiced with kids anymore!)
 - c. Request and Reunion Form discussion
2. Communication to parents will be through district
3. In case of big event, we have supplies, plan, first responders, (parent volunteers for reunion piece?)
4. Make sure Infinite Campus is set up for reunion (gate @ secondary pickup), plan for a Wednesday.
5. Playground:
 - a. See something say something - need more training
 - b. Antiquated equipment (Gaga pit, big playground?)
 - c. Kid injuries are not being communicated in a timely/and or effective manner
 - d. Staff will participate in a case study
 - e. Gaga Ball not ADA compliant, need to contact Rotary (who donated)
 - f. Students can give input for new equipment or replacements
 - g. We are incredibly understaffed on playground (sign-up genius are still around!) Is there a description that can be added for duty? 5th grade student helpers being trained – can they make videos? 5th grade helpers on playground?

- h. How can we dream and get kids involved in redesigning/fund raising?

V. Wellness Survey Results

1. Color-coded by needs
2. 20 kids popped up with needs (a few reds, some yellows)
3. Survey involved asking students about their joy of learning, school connections, voice and choice, feeling like they can be themselves, etc.
